

>> Janelle: this is episode 1, developing your employees.

There you will click on the link, the supervisor see updates a window will appear asking for your name, e-mail address and password.

The password is supervisor with a capital S and the number 1 after.

Once you have entered this information you will be on the site and you can ask any question that you may have.

>> Don: Remember, folks, everything that we've covered in the broadcast today is available on our website that we've set up for you.

If you look on the bottom of the screen, it shows the URL for the website, and you can go on and you can look at any time you want to the particular episodes.

My recommendation is from the index page that we're showing here, go ahead and bookmark that so you can come back to it.

So if you miss out on January's episode, you can always come back later and you can see everything that you missed.
